Two stories from this week. On Wednesday night, our boys under their coach Mr Plumb and trainer Mr Peebles, were successful in the Rugby League Grand Final for the Development Cup. In the fourteen years we have been playing in the Cup, we have only made it to the grand-final three times previously, and on each occasion we were beaten by Norville. The commitment to themselves, each other and their team was fantastic from our players, and their effort made their win a particularly worthy one.

On Thursday, we had an altercation between two boys. A girl from the class, who I have always considered to be quiet and fairly shy, was the first to step in and help to stop the fight. I had always liked and admired this young lady, but I had not imagined that one so young, would have had the courage and maturity, to step up with absolute confidence and do what

was needed. Many adults would have been reluctant to step in under the circumstances, and yet she didn't hesitate to do what was right. As soon as she took this bold step, others stepped in also. What amazing leadership. I shared these stories, because they illustrate that we really don't know people and what they are truly capable of. We think we do, and we are all fairly quick to judge people and to categorize them, and yet in reality there are a myriad of strengths that we have failed to see through our own blindness.

Year 4L challenged us in prayer this week to look for kindness, and I was both surprised and delighted with how much we all found. My experiences this week have taught me to look also for greatness in others. There is far more there than we see at first glance and people are far more than our narrow perception of them.
