I was delighted to realize that the things this young man loved about our school, are still so evident today. The care, the relationships, the challenges, and the sheer satisfaction that comes from mastering something new.

Today as we celebrate World Teachers' Day, I would love to simply acknowledge the most fantastic staff ever, and thank them for the wonderful job they do each and every day. 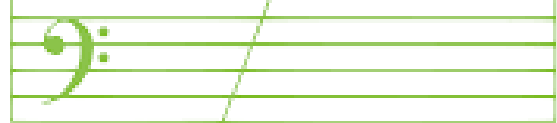
