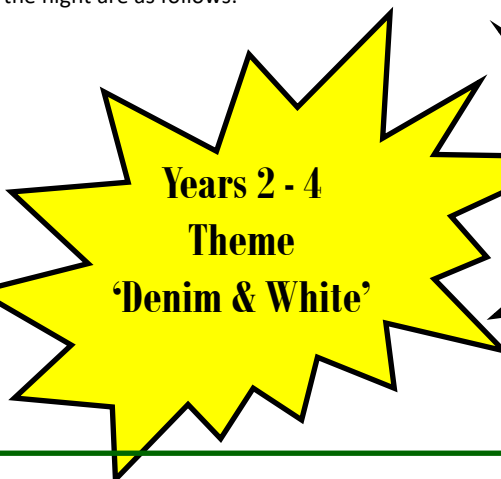
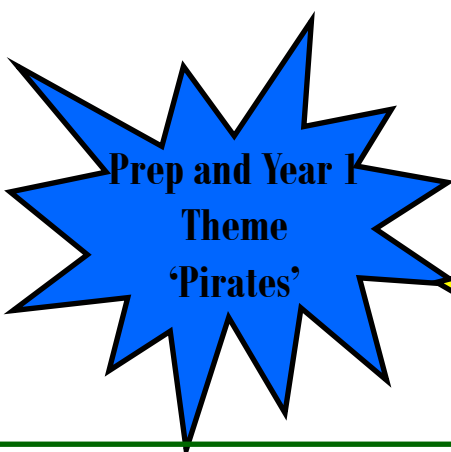
Thursday 12th March

BUNDABERG DISTRICT U12 SCHOOL SPORTS TRIALS—2020

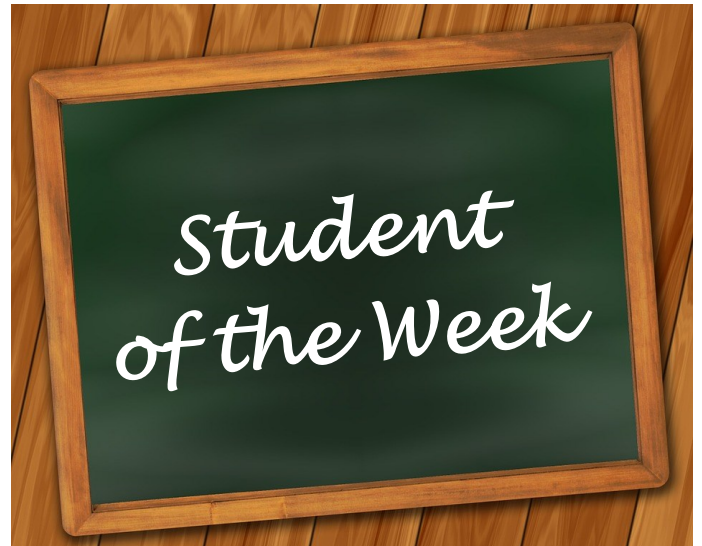
